Office Memorandum

विषय : Approval of "Om Research & Testing Laboratory Private Limited" for Independent Testing facilities for works under ADG (Patna).

In exercise of powers vested as per SOP No 5/16 and 7/2 for CPWD Works Manual 2024 and modifications issued vide OM No DG/SOP-2024/07 dated 29.10.2024, the competent authority is pleased to approve Om Research & Testing Laboratory Private Limited, Sukhdeo Nagar, Ratu Road, Ranchi- 834005 (Jharkhand) (Phone No. 07362037216, E-mail: omlaboratories2019@gmail.com), NABL accredited private testing laboratory for a period of one year from the date of issue of this letter, for testing of materials to be used for Building construction, as per scope of NABL accreditation TC No-8933 dated 17.07.2024 to be used in various ongoing and upcoming projects under jurisdiction of ADG (Patna).


1. All testing equipments / instruments shall be calibrated / maintained at fixed Intervals through authenticated service providers during the approval period.
2. The lab shall remain open to inspections by authorized representatives of CPWD as and when required, with or without prior intimation. The lab shall allow witnessing of testing by the CPWD Engineers or their authorized representatives. Video recording of testing of materials shall be done, whenever required.
3. The laboratories shall retain the balance materials after testing for at least thirty days from the date of report sent to the department.
4. On receiving of samples, the lab shall perform the tests within prescribed period as per CPWD specifications/BIS or other relevant codes/standards and shall submit the test results/reports within three days of conducting tests.
5. The lab shall report the acknowledgement of receipt of samples on same day via e-mail to AE/EE/SE/CE and to the contractor, Soft copy in PDF format of Test Reports shall be sent to the offices on the date of issue of Test Reports as well as hard copies in original to the Engineer-in-Charge of the work and to the contractor.
6. To assess the correctness of the test results, laboratory samples at random, may also be sent to the Government lab for testing and if any variation is found, the results would be informed to the concerned laboratory. If there is any gross variation in the analytical reports furnished by the concerned laboratories (either pass or fail) with that of a Government Lab on three occasions in a period. If there is any gross variation in the analytical reports furnished by the con of one year, the concerned laboratory may be debarred for a period of two years.
7. The approved lab is liable to be debarred for a minimum period of one year in case any adverse remarks are received against the laboratory or repeated delays in issue of test reports for more than 7 days, are reported by Executive Engineer to the approval authority.

8. The approval will automatically lapse after the expiry of this period unless renewed.
9. Approval can be withdrawn prematurely without assigning any reason on complaints if found true on uncalled action of the lab.
10. The approval does not make the firm eligible for claiming right to take the work done through them which is subjected to their competitive stand amongst other qualifying specialized firms in field to avail material testing facilities.
11. The approval given does not absolve the supervisory officer of CPWD of their responsibility ensuring quality of work.
